THIS WEEK'S LESSON: DAY 3



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

On the third day of creation, God created the land, the seas, lovely trees and beautiful plants. God is beautiful and there is beauty in all that He created. Genesis 1:9-13, The Third Day



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Get away from the things of man for a bit, and get out to nature, even just to take a walk. Look for beauty in nature, and ask your kids how that beauty reminds them of God.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- What did God do on the third day?
- Why did God make the Earth beautiful?
- How does natural beauty remind us of God?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"The earth belongs to the Lord. And so does everything in it. The world belongs to him. And so do all those who live in it." Psalm 24:1 (NirV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:
